



Basic principles for distinguishing between household and industrial products

Grey List

(FROM DECLARATION YEAR 2023 ONWARDS)

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01 Definitions

Household packaging waste is packaging waste arising from the normal activity of households. This packaging must be declared to Fost Plus, the accredited body for the management of household packaging.

Industrial packaging waste is all packaging waste that is not considered household packaging waste. This packaging must be declared to Valipac, the accredited body for the management of industrial packaging.

02 Application

In consultation with the Interregional Packaging Commission, rules have been drawn up to determine whether a product is household or industrial in nature. A product is either household or industrial. It can never be both at the same time. The following rules apply when determining the origin of products and their packaging.

- **Sales packaging or primary packaging:** any packaging conceived so as to constitute a sales unit for the final user or consumer at the point of sale. Primary packaging is either household or industrial. The decision tree below is used to make the distinction.
- **Grouped packaging or secondary packaging:** any packaging conceived so as to constitute at the point of sale a grouping of a certain number of sales units, whether the latter is sold as such to the final user or consumer or whether it serves only as a means to replenish the shelves at the point of sale; it can be removed from the product without affecting its characteristics. Secondary packaging is industrial, with the exception of household multipacks. A multipack is a packaging that groups together several individually packaged consumption units and that is intended to be sold to consumers in that form. For more information, please consult the websites of the IVCIE, Fost Plus or Valipac.
- **Transport packaging or tertiary packaging:** any packaging conceived so as to facilitate the handling and transport of a number of sales units or grouped packagings in order to prevent damage during handling and transport. Transport packaging does not include road, rail, ship and air containers. Tertiary packaging is industrial, with the exception of household parcel packaging. Parcel packaging is a specific form of tertiary packaging that only applies to sales to private individuals in the context of a purchase

made over the internet, by mail order or by carrier. The original primary packaging of the product is never considered parcel packaging. All transport/tertiary packaging used for the sale of products to companies by express courier, by mail order or over the internet is industrial packaging.

- **Service packaging:** this is all packaging used at the moment goods or services are made available to consumers. Such packaging is generally only applied at the moment of sale to the consumer. Service packaging only applies in the field of household packaging. For more information, please consult the websites of the IVCIE, Valipac or Fost Plus.

- This grey list only applies to products whose packaging is single-use.

Important remarks:

⁽¹⁾ If a product identical to yours is distributed by competitors through distribution channels aimed at private individuals, you must consult the list below. The distribution channel is therefore not a decisive factor, unless you can clearly and concretely demonstrate that the product is industrial.

⁽²⁾ Where the primary packaging of a product is composed in such a way that using the product requires professional equipment, the primary packaging of that product is industrial. Example: a beer keg that has to be connected to a professional beer-dispensing installation.

03 Spare parts and accessories

- **Spare parts** are the individual elements whose assembly or mounting forms a constructed object. Spare parts serve only for the repair of an object or piece of equipment, mainly carried out by a specialist. Spare parts are industrial.
- **Accessories** complement a product and are therefore treated in the same way as the main product:

Example: PC = industrial -> accessories for a PC: mouse = industrial

-> spare part for a PC: motherboard = industrial

Bicycle = household -> accessories for a bicycle: bungee cord = household

-> spare part for a bicycle: brake = industrial

04 The list distinguishing household and industrial products • Grey List

04.01 Introduction

This list was drawn up by Valipac and Fost Plus in close cooperation with the professional federations. It has been approved by the Interregional Packaging Commission (IVCIE/CIE) and is revised on a regular basis.

04.02 Use

- For each product, the list indicates whether the product and its primary packaging is considered household (Fost Plus) or industrial (Valipac). In other cases, the product is either household or industrial depending on the net quantity of the product (often shown on the packaging with the symbol 'e').

Example: rice: $e \leq 5 \text{ kg}$ = household $e > 5 \text{ kg}$ = industrial

All primary packaging of rice of 5 kg or less is household packaging. Primary packaging of rice of more than 5 kg is industrial packaging.

- When consulting the list, bear in mind that it concerns the packaging of the products mentioned. In some places you will find an * next to a product. This * symbol means that the product may itself be a packaging. For each product, the list gives the product family (Fost Plus nomenclature) or the product group (Valipac nomenclature).

- If the limits above are exceeded during promotional offers, the packaging of products intended for the normal activity of households remains household packaging.
- Portion packs of ordinary household products intended for direct individual consumption, in a quantity designed for single use, are always considered household packaging. Whether the packaging of the sales unit is household or industrial is determined by the list above.

- The following are considered industrial, whatever the weight and/or volume: the primary packaging of products whose nature or composition is intended for professional or industrial use.
- The primary packaging of products packed individually in order to meet hygiene requirements and intended to be cut up or repacked is considered industrial.
- Packaging, including service packaging, used to present prepared meals to the consumer is always considered household packaging (examples: catering, self-service restaurants, fast food restaurants, etc.).
